

TUSCOLA COUNTY ELECTION NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that a Primary Election will be held in Tuscola County on

TUESDAY, AUGUST 4, 2020

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS: Of the Tuscola County Townships of Akron, Almer Charter, Arbel, Columbia, Dayton, Denmark, Elkland, Ellington, Elmwood, Fairgrove, Fremont, Gilford, Indianfields, Juniata, Kingston, Koylton, Millington, Novesta, Tuscola, Vassar, Watertown, Wells, Wisner and the Cities of Caro and Vassar, State of Michigan:

ALL JURISDICTIONS	PRIMARY ELECTION
	Candidates of the Democratic Party and the Republican Party seeking nomination to the following partisan offices are to be voted for: US Senator, Representative in Congress, State Representative, County Offices of Prosecuting Attorney, Sheriff, Clerk, Treasurer, Register of Deeds, Road Commissioner, Drain Commissioner, County Commissioner and Township Offices of Supervisor, Clerk, Treasurer, Trustee and Precinct Delegates for the Democratic Party and the Republican Party.
TUSCOLA COUNTY	MOSQUITO CONTROL AND ABATEMENT PROPOSAL
	Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Tuscola County, Michigan, be renewed at .6316 mills (\$.6316 for each \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of six (6) years from 2020 to 2025, inclusive, to finance the control and abatement of mosquitoes in Tuscola County? If approved and levied in its entirety, this millage raises an estimated \$1,131,904 in the first calendar year after its approval. All revenue will be disbursed only to Tuscola County and shall be exclusively used for mosquito control and abatement services to property within Tuscola County. This is a renewal of a previously voter-approved authorization that will expire before the effective date of this authorization.
AKRON TOWNSHIP	ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE MILLAGE PROPOSAL RENEWAL
	Shall the limitation of the amount of property taxes which may be assessed each year against property in the Township of Akron, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, be renewed for a period of four (4) years: 2020 through 2023 inclusive, up to 0.9462 mill on the valuation of the taxable real and personal property situated in the Township of Akron, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, said millage to be used exclusively for Road Construction and Maintenance, as provided for by Section 6, Article 9 of the 1963 Constitution of the State of Michigan? This proposal will raise in the first year of the levy an estimated sum of \$144,632.35 and a like amount in subsequent years.
ALMER CHARTER TOWNSHIP	ROAD RENEWAL PROPOSAL
	Shall Almer Charter Township, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 1.0 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expires in 2020, against all taxable property within the Township for a period of four (4) years, 2021 to 2024, inclusive, for the purpose of constructing, preserving, improving, repairing, and maintaining roads, bridges, and street systems within Almer Charter Township? The estimate of the revenue the Township will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Township in the first year (2021) is approximately \$64,636.76.
COLUMBIA TOWNSHIP	LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL
	Shall Columbia Township, County of Tuscola, Michigan, levy a tax of up to 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for 7 years, 2021 through 2027 for operating and maintaining the township public library? If approved and levied, the millage renewal will raise estimated revenues of \$183,000 in the first year.
DENMARK TOWNSHIP	ADDITIONAL ROAD MILLAGE PROPOSAL
	Shall Denmark Township impose an additional millage of up to 1.0 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution, and levy it for six years, December 1, 2020 through December 1, 2025 inclusive, for the purpose of raising revenues for the maintenance and improvement of public roads in Denmark Township, raising an estimated \$108,779.41 in the first year the millage is levied?
ELKLAND TOWNSHIP	FIRE DEPARTMENT AND AMBULANCE MILLAGE PROPOSAL RENEWAL
	For the purpose of providing fire and ambulance services within Elkland Township, County of Tuscola, shall the Township increase the limitation in the total amount of ad valorem taxes which may be imposed for all purposes of purchasing, equipping and maintaining fire equipment and providing ambulance services for the Township of Elkland as provided in the Michigan Constitution of 1963, as amended, which would result in a renewal of the levy of 1.00 mills (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for the period of six (6) years, in the years 2021 to 2026 inclusive. This levy is estimated to raise \$96,993 in the first year.
INDIANFIELDS TOWNSHIP	IRREVOCABLE LIMITED FRANCHISE PROPOSAL
	Shall Indianfields Township grant a 30-year irrevocable limited franchise to the City of Caro to transact a public water utility business and provide public water service solely to Caro Center Hospital pursuant to MCL 460.601, <i>et seq</i> ?
KOYLTON TOWNSHIP	IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF ROADS RENEWAL PROPOSAL
	Shall the previously voted increase in the 15 mill tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Section 6, of the Michigan Constitution on general ad valorem taxes within Koylton Township be renewed at 2 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of 4 years, 2021 through 2024 inclusive, for the sole and exclusive purpose of the improvement and maintenance of roads within Koylton Township and shall the Township levy such renewal millage for the said purpose, thereby, raising in the first year an estimated \$75,000.00?
UNIONVILLE SEBEWAING AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT	UNIONVILLE-SEBEWAING AREA SCHOOLS GENERAL OBLIGATION UNLIMITED TAX BOND PROPOSAL FOR BUILDING AND SITE PURPOSES IN THE AMOUNT OF NOT TO EXCEED \$2,570,000

Please take further notice that the bonds of the school district, if approved by a majority vote of the electors at this election, will be general obligation unlimited tax bonds payable from general ad valorem taxes.
CARO AREA DISTRICT LIBRARY	LIBRARY MILLAGE RENEWAL
	Shall the Caro Area District Library, County of Tuscola, State of Michigan, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed 1.4909 mills (\$1.4909 on each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expired in 2019, against all taxable property within the Caro Area District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2020 to 2029, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Caro Area District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2020) if the millage is approved and levied by the District Library is approximately \$432,000.
