

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
INDIANFIELDS TOWNSHIP, TUSCOLA COUNTY
ADOPTION OF NEW ZONING ORDINANCE**

The Indianfields Township Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on November 11, 2020, to consider and hear public comment concerning the adoption of a new Township Zoning Ordinance. The public hearing will be held by joint electronic remote access and in-person attendance at the Indianfields Township Hall, located at 111 Joy Street, Caro, MI 48723.
