**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE BALLOT LANGUAGE
FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE**

At a meeting of the Indianfields Township Board held on the 14th day of March, 2022, this resolution was offered by Trustee Woloshen and supported by Trustee E. King.

WHEREAS, the Township Board desires to submit to the electors of Indianfields Township the question, of imposing a millage, for purposes of road maintenance and Improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that;

The Indianfields Township Board hereby, directs that a millage proposal be submitted, to the electors of Indianfields Township, on the question of raising money, for Road improvement and maintaince at a special election to be held, at the time of the primary election, on August 2, 2022.

The ballot proposal shall be worded as follows:

ROAD IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE PROPOSITION

Shall Indianfields Township impose a renewal, of up to 2.00 mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6, of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for four (4) years, 2022 through 2026 inclusive, for road improvement and maintenance? The renewal would result in, an estimated revenue of \$131,750.00 each year, that the millage is levied.
